Using Bouncy Castles or Other Land Based Inflatables

The Hall's Public Liability Insurance has an extension that covers the non-commercial hirers of the hall to use Bouncy castles or other land based inflatables providing that you adhere to the following guidelines:

You as the hirer must ensure that:

- 1. Access and use is controlled by an authorised adult at all times.
- 2. The bouncy castle must not be used outside the Hall building.
- 3. Soft matting should be used to cover hard surfaces adjacent to the front or any open sides where there is a risk of injury from falling from the inflatable. Please check, **in advance**, with the owner of the bouncy castle that they will provide all the matting necessary as often they only put matting at the exit.
- 4. You follow the manufacturer's or supplier's safety recommendations.
- 5. Users of the castle must remove articles like shoes, buckles, jewellery or any sharp items.
- 6. You do not allow overcrowding, particularly by children (to prevent knocking into each other).
- 7. You do not allow a mix of large and small children at the same time (to avoid larger children crushing the smaller ones).
- 8. You do not allow adults and children at the same time.
- 9. You do not allow any access to the very youngest children, eg under 2 years old.

If you do not follow these guidelines then any insurance claim that arises may not be covered.

Material damage for any bouncy castle/inflatable is not included in the Hall Insurance policy and is the responsibility of the owner.

Please note that West Moors Memorial Hall does not permit the use of trampolines.
